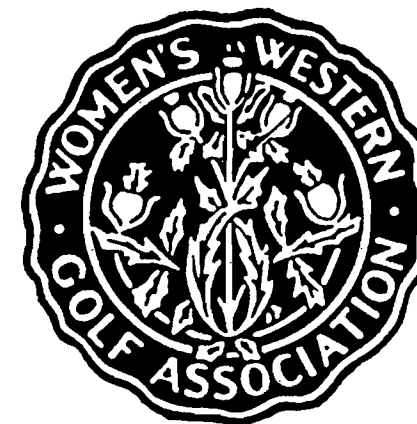
The WWGA's rich tradition encompasses all ages by conducting three national championships annually and is one of the oldest and most revered women's golf organizations in the United States.
